THE 2010 OVERLAND JUDITH WRIGHT POETRY PRIZE FOR NEW AND EMERGING POETS

GUIDELINES

1. The award is open to poets who have not yet had a collection of their work commercially published: that is, by a publishing house with commercial distribution.
2. Entrants must be Australian citizens or permanent residents.
3. Selection will be made by *Overland's* poetry editor, Peter Minter.
4. The judge's decision will be final.
5. The winning poem will be published in *Overland*.
6. All submitted poems may be considered for publication in *Overland*.
7. Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and a \$11.00 administration fee (the fee is only \$5.50 for subscribers).
8. The name of the poet must not appear on the manuscript since all poems will be considered anonymously.
9. A maximum of three unpublished poems is allowed per entry.
10. Two copies of each poem must be submitted.
11. You can enter as many times as you like.
12. Electronic submissions will not be considered.
13. Entry form and payment must be received by Monday 15 November 2010; entries postmarked after this date will not be accepted.
14. Winners will be announced in March 2011.
Include a stamped, self-addressed envelope if you require results posted.
15. The major prize is \$5000.
16. Two runner-up prizes of \$1000 each will be awarded at the discretion of the judge.
17. All care will be taken but no responsibility can be accepted for lost or damaged manuscripts.
18. Manuscripts will not be returned.
